

Using brads to fasten Art and Glass in a Picture Frame

Most picture framers use a special tool to press brads into the inside of the frame because it doesn't stress the mitered corners. Instead it squeezes the brad into the frame like a clamp on the outside of the frame and inside on the brad.

For occasional picture framing it doesn't make much sense to buy an expensive tool, but here's a way to get it done without knocking the corners apart.
