

Here's a REAL CS Miter gauge!

A while back we had some give and take on the usefulness of the rip gauge for a circular saw.

My contention is that there is such a thing as a good rip gauge for a CS, but not the little tin thang they sell with some of 'em.

The two photos at right show my CS rip gauge, set up to go across a 48" plywood panel.

The extruded aluminum bar clamps to the work from underneath and the plastic sled tracks the saw perfectly. A little dust pickup completes the picture.



And just so you don't get the idea I abandoned my router ethic, The picture at left shows how this handy-dandy guide adapts to a router!
